

Dear Parent/Carer,

With the absence of AS exams our year 12 students will be sitting a series of end of year internal exams. The timetable for these can be found below. These exams will assess student's progress over the first year of their A Level course and allow us to ascertain whether students will be able to continue on their courses into Year 13. **Please encourage your child to take these exams seriously as they could be a deciding factor in their future studies.**

It is crucially important that students prepare for these exams and we will ensure that they are doing so in lessons. We appreciate your support in also ensuring that students are working at home. They should be doing revision every evening and for a period of time at weekends as well as completing any homework set by teachers. We would recommend students devising a revision timetable to ensure that they are preparing for all subjects in equal measures.

Practice of exam questions is one of the best forms of revision as it gives students an idea of the nature of exam questions and techniques. On the school website, we have put a link to a document with a number of study skills and revision strategies for students to use during their preparation, as well as document with suggestions of how you, as parents, can also help to support your child in making the most out of their revision.
