



## Maths Marking and Feedback Policy

### Marking could include:

- SMART teacher comments / targets
- References to pupils' current level and target level
- Dialogue with students (responding to teacher questions / tasks)
- Comments that demonstrate to pupils how to make progress
- Incorporating DIRT time into lessons so that students can respond appropriately

### Key Stage 3 and Key Stage 4

<b>All books must contain</b>	<b>A start of Year / Target Level sticker</b>
	<b>Topic sheet</b> – RAG rated by students before and at the end of a topic
<b>Formal Assessments</b>	To be marked by teachers
<b>Marking expectations for one marking cycle (min)</b>  Over the course of the year, ten topic sheets will be added to the pupils' books.  Each one marks the start of a marking cycle	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Topic sheet</b> (pupils should RAG rate their own ability with each of the objectives before and after topic is covered)</li> <li>• <b>Self assessment</b> in green pen (can be in the form of a marking sticker). <b>Students will mark some of their own classwork.</b></li> <li>• <b>Peer assessment</b> in green pen (can be in the form of a marking sticker) <b>Students will mark some of their peer's classwork.</b></li> <li>• <b>A marking sticker by the teacher</b></li> </ul> <p><u>Deciding what to mark</u>          Assess each topic as a whole with a marking sticker by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Setting a mini test</li> <li>✓ Choosing a key piece of class work, i.e. a mixed exercise</li> <li>✓ Looking at the class work and homework for the topic as a whole</li> <li>✓ Verbal feedback (stamp) can be given if backed up by pupil response notes in the exercise book.</li> </ul>
<b>DIRT Time</b>  Dedicated Improvement and Reflection Time for Pupils.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>A Pupil Progress Response page</b> – This is a blank space/page left directly after the marking sticker for pupils to act on your advice. Make sure pupils write the title and highlight it in some way.</li> </ul> <p><u>Ideas for the Progress Response:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Corrections of certain questions</li> <li>✓ Challenge questions</li> <li>✓ Work missed when absent</li> <li>✓ Research</li> <li>✓ Further practice</li> </ul>
