

## **PE Department Marking Policy**

Marking – best practice will include:

- SMART teacher comments / targets
- Red pen teacher comments/ Green pen pupil and peer feedback
- References to pupils' current level and target level
- Dialogue with students (responding to teacher questions / tasks)
- Comments that demonstrate to pupils how to make progress
- Incorporating DIRT time into lessons so that students can respond appropriately

	(with DIRT built in for student reflection) Make sure teachers are addressing pupil's
	current grade and further challenges for pupils.
	Self / Peer feedback: 1 traffic light sticker per term
	Verbal feedback stamp: To be used once per term
	3, 2, 1 sticker to be used after each Unit (allow 15minutes for this self reflection)
	Each unit should have a unit speciation outline (stuck in or printed up and stuck into
	their books) 1 DIRT opportunity provided in class for student reflection (purple pen)
Class work and Homework	Class work and Homework must have a title and date.
	All homework is to be marked and given a grade. If homework or class work is not
	complete you must date this piece of work to keep track of pupils completing their
	work.
	Worksheets either stuck in their books or inside an A4 wallet attached to their books by
	a treasury tag.

	Pupils should receive feedback on all homework tasks.
